Dear Appleton East Junior Patriots Baseball,

The bells have gone silent after another season of bell ringing, and at The Salvation Army – Fox Cities we are so grateful for the generosity of the community once again in 2014. Over 1,886 volunteers contributed 9,421 hours to bell ringing in the Fox Cities! And thanks to the support of our volunteers and generous donors, we have met and exceeded our Christmas campaign goal of \$1.2 million!

We especially appreciate your group's partnership with us throughout the season. Your time ringing bells helped to raise much needed funds. With your support, we are able to provide programs and services to help those in need at Christmas and throughout the year.

In 2014 there were 1,992 households in the Fox Cities that received Christmas assistance by Salvation Army programs: 477 families were sponsored via Adopt-A-Family, 1,339 families received toys and food through the general Salvation Army Christmas Distribution, and 176 adult-only households received holiday food assistance. In addition, The Salvation Army food pantry provides groceries to the area's needy throughout the year and the Noon Meal Program serves lunch daily.

On behalf of all those we serve, **thank you so much** for your support of our 2014 Red Kettle Campaign. We look forward to continuing to work with you in 2015!
